If you have not yet publicized this scholarship to your students, the enclosed sheet will provide you with the application criteria and information to post on your website or otherwise share with the student body.

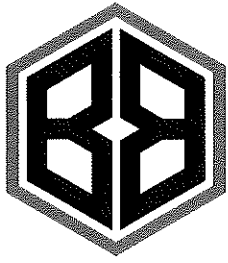
