

**Status of Coronavirus Emergency Financial Aid to Students (Federal Reporting)  
Higher Education Emergency Relief Funds, Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and  
Economic Security (CARES) Act & Higher Education Relief Funds II (CRRSAA),  
and American Rescue Plan (ARP)**

**As of December 31, 2021**

- 1) Carteret Community College (College) signed and returned to the Department of Education (Department) the College's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the CARES Act and the supplement under section 18004(a)(1) CRRSA under section 314(a)(1), and Arp under section 2003(a)(1). This includes assurance that the College has used, or intends to use, no less than \$2,455,407 collectively to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.
- 2) The College was initially funded \$387,473 and an additional \$387,473 supplement and another additional supplement of \$1,680,461 from the Department pursuant to the College's Certification of Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.
- 3) As of the date of this report, the College distributed \$1,778,027.25 to 2,297 students.
- 4) The estimated total number of the College's students eligible to participate in the programs under Section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965 and thus eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act is 905
- 5) Students and potential students eligible to receive an Emergency Financial Aid Grant were reached through a college funded marketing campaign which included Facebook, Instagram, TikTok, YouTube, and Spotify. Links were established to direct students to the college webpage (Exhibit 1) for more information and an application.
- 6) Students are encouraged to consult with Financial Aid for information about emergency needs. Application and consent form (Exhibit 2) were collected and reviewed by Financial Aid (Exhibit 3).

### WHAT DOES FULL FUNDING MEAN?

The Full Funding program enables Carteret CC to offer ALL degree seeking students the chance to attend college free of in-state tuition, student fees, and course books.

### HOW DO I QUALIFY FOR SPRING 2022 FULL FUNDING?

In order to qualify for Spring 2022 Full Funding, students must meet the following requirements:

1. **Complete a 2021-2022 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by December 1, 2021.**

- Students DO NOT need to be Pell eligible to receive Full Funding; however, a **2021-2022 FAFSA application MUST be completed** so that Carteret CC can match students with grants, scholarships, and other awards. Career and College Promise (CCP) students DO NOT need to apply for FAFSA for the Spring 2022 Full Funding program.

2. **Enrolled in a degree, diploma, or certificate program**

- The Full Funding program is available for specific workforce training courses. Student eligibility is determined on a case-by-case basis. For a list of continuing education courses [click here](#).

3. **Complete the Spring 2022 Full Funding Application**
