



MARINE PROPULSION SYSTEMS Certificate

The Marine Propulsion Technology certificate is designed to train marine technicians to service the outboard marine industry.

Graduates will qualify for entry-level technician work at boat maintenance facilities as well as parts department sales.

To complete the certificate, students must earn 15 credit hours of college credit listed in the table.
