Course Codes are listed as: Subject-Course-Section Number (Ex. ACA 122 HYN1)

The section number determines several identifiers for the class.



1st 8 Week

Section runs the 1st 8 weeks of the semester.



2nd 8 Week

Section runs the 2nd 8 weeks of the semester.



Late Start

Sections start after the beginning of the term.



Internet

100% of the instruction is delivered asynchronously via the internet/online.

BL

Blended

Instruction is delivered face-to-face but gives the instructor the flexibility to offer less than 50% of instruction online (ex. inclement weather or making up lecture hours).

HY

Hybrid

50% but less than 100% of instruction is delivered asynchronously online with occasional face-to-face meetings at a scheduled time and place.

ΗF

Hyflex

The option to attend sessions in the classroom, participate in sessions online, synchronously, or asynchronously, or do any combination as long as attendance is maintained weekly. Students can change their mode of attendance.

S

Synchronous

Course content is delivered in an instructor-led class on a fixed schedule virtually in which both students and instructor are present online at the same time. Students will be required to use a web camera to participate.

Night

Classes delivered after 4pm.

W

Winter Mini Term

Section offered during Winter break.

X

Off Campus

Courses, clinicals, or web based learning offered off campus.

The section number determines several identifiers for the class.

*Asynchronous: learning environment allowing a student to learn on their own schedule, within a deadline set by course syllabi.

A: 1st 8 Week

College curriculum course that begins at the start of the semester.

B: 2nd 8 Week

College curriculum course that begins at the conclusion of the first 8 weeks of the semester.

L: Late Start

All sections that begin after the beginning of the term with an alternative or abbreviated schedule includes this identifier in the section number.

IN: Internet

College curriculum course in which 100% of the instruction is delivered asynchronously via the internet/online.

BL: Blended

College curriculum course that meets face-to-face but gives the instructor the flexibility to offer less than 50% of instruction online (ex. inclement weather or making up lecture hours).

HY: Hybrid

Hybrid is a course model where 50% but less than 100% of instruction is delivered asynchronously online with occasional face-to-face meetings at a scheduled time and place. Instructional delivery methods may include, but are not limited to: Internet, Moodle, or other media.

HF: Hyflex

Hyflex is a course model with components of hybrid learning in a flexible course structure, providing students with the option to attend sessions in the classroom participate in sessions online, synchronously, or asynchronously, or do any combination as long as attendance is maintained weekly. Students can change their mode of attendance weekly or by topic, according to need or preference.

S: Synchronous

An online synchronous section is one where course content is delivered in an instructor-led class on a fixed schedule virtually in which both students and instructor are present online at the same time. Students will be required to use a web camera to participate. The fixed schedule is pre-designed with a designated day and time per week. Ex.: MW 10-10:50 AM

N: Night

Classes delivered after 4 PM.

W: Winter Mini Term

College curriculum course offered during Winter break.

X: Off Campus

College curriculum course, clinical, or work-based learning offered off campus.
