Additional Information: Minimum Requirements: The requirements to become a firefighter in West Virginia would vary according the city you are applying to. However, generally speaking, the requirements would be on the following lines: All candidates

must have at least a high school diploma or a GED, all candidates must be citizens of the US, all candidates must have a valid driver's license, all candidates must not have any prior felony convictions or a criminal record, all candidates must show proof of residency as required by their local department, all candidates must clear the written, oral, physical, medical and psychological tests and interviews, all candidates should have an EMT certification, and all candidates ought to have some volunteer firefighting experience (variable according to city requirements). In addition to the above requirements, it is recommended that aspiring firefighters in West Virginia go for an undergraduate degree in Fire

Science or a related subject.

Additional Information: Minimum Requirements: Even though the exact requirements vary according to jurisdiction, the following general requirements are usually applicable. Be at least 18 years of age, have a valid driver's license, have a high school diploma or

a GED/HSED, have a State of Wisconsin Firefighter I or equivalent, and be a nationally registered EMT-Basic. Some jurisdictions might also require an Associate's Degree in Fire Protection or Fire Science, along with certifications or licenses. In addition to that, several cities in the state require candidates to be citizens of the US as well and have a Hazmat Operations level certification. To make sure you have fulfilled all the relevant requirements, you are advised to check with the local city fire department you intend to apply. Some cities also have a residency requirement – for instance, Ashland firefighters are required to live within 15 miles from the limits of the city of Ashland.
